

# EMERGENCY APPEAL 12/2022



### PROJECT GOAL

The goal of the project was material assistance and integration of war refugees from Ukraine into Czech society. The help was mainly intended for vulnerable people such as children, parents with small or more children, lonely women, the elderly and people with health problems.

The project was financially supported by donors from the Caritas Internationalis network and a donation from Caritas Czech Republic. The total amount provided for the project reached the amount of CZK 39,246,392/EUR 1,613,259 and 40,309 people were supported from it, while more than half of the people were supported more than once.

## INTEGRATION SUPPORT

CZK 11,526,502/EUR 473, 807 was paid from the project for the work of integration workers who played a key role in providing aid to refugees. They helped with official matters, accompanied and interpreted during visits to doctors, schools, employers, when processing visas, state subsidies, helped with accommodation, care for children, the elderly and people with special health requirements. A big thank you goes to them too.

### INEGRATION SOCIAL EVENTS

From October 2022 to April 2023, the Caritas organized 23 events for children from Ukraine.

More than 500 children took part in the events.

Children celebrated St. Nicholas, Czech and Ukrainian Christmas and Easter, burned witches, went swimming, were in the technical museum, in the maze, make art and practice.
